

- »PROJECT/CAUSE nominated by on-going or previous projects which have been helped by volunteers, parents, children members.
- »PROJECT TEAM IDENTIFY AND
 ASSESS NEEDS ensuring the
 cause is genuine and that the
 beneficiaries are children
- » AGREEMENT there is a policy not to hand over any cash funds directly to supported causes but to work with them to fulfil their needs.
- » DELIVER SUPPORT a local contact is established to maintain on-going communications.
